

## Requirements

Minimum of 18 years old

Valid Florida Driver's License

Jeep Wrangler (or similar Jeep) to allow for off road navigation

Desire to be a team member to assist with office work or Search and Rescue

Vehicle insurance - Provide Proof of liability and personal injury insurance coverage with application and provide Declaration page.

Pass a Volunteer background investigation

Successfully complete all training provided with a passing score

- **Probation for first 6 months.**

- During this time -
- \* Attend Initial Jeep Unit Orientation Meeting
  - \* Attend at least 4 of 6 monthly meetings/trainings
  - \* Complete Online CERT Training
  - \* ICS 100 / 200/ 700/ 800 (within first 3 months)

- \* **No later than 12 months must complete -**

- Classroom CERT

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provides on-line training under the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and Incident Command System (ICS).

The National Incident Management System (NIMS) is a systematic, proactive approach to guide departments and agencies at all levels of government, nongovernmental organizations, and the private sector to work together seamlessly and manage incidents involving all threats and hazards—regardless of cause, size, location, or complexity—in order to reduce loss of life, property and harm to the environment. The NIMS is the essential foundation to the [National Preparedness System \(NPS\)](#) and provides the template for the management of incidents and operations
